THE DIRECTOR'S CORNER



"We see what we want to see."

It's a phrase that has been rattling around in my head lately — and the more I sit with it, the more I believe it may be the most important idea we can explore together this year.

Think about the last time you watched a film with someone you love and walked out to discover you had each witnessed something entirely different. One of you was moved to tears. The other was unmoved. One saw a hero. The other saw a villain. Same screen. Same story. Two completely different experiences.

We don't just watch with our eyes. We watch with our histories, our fears, our hopes, and our wounds. A scene about a father and a son lands differently depending on the father you had — or the one you wished for. This is not a flaw in how we experience art. That is the whole point. And it is precisely why gathering together — in book clubs, in film clubs, in festival audiences — matters so profoundly right now.

When we share the same story and turn to one another to compare what we saw, we are not just talking about a film. We are offering each other a window into a life we might never have encountered on our own. In a world increasingly determined to show us only what we already agree with, a film festival is almost a radical act.

My hope for this, our 10th anniversary, is that you let these films surprise you — and let the person sitting next to you see something you missed. The most extraordinary thing cinema offers us is not escapism. It is empathy.

Come. Watch. Listen. And then — please — talk to each other.

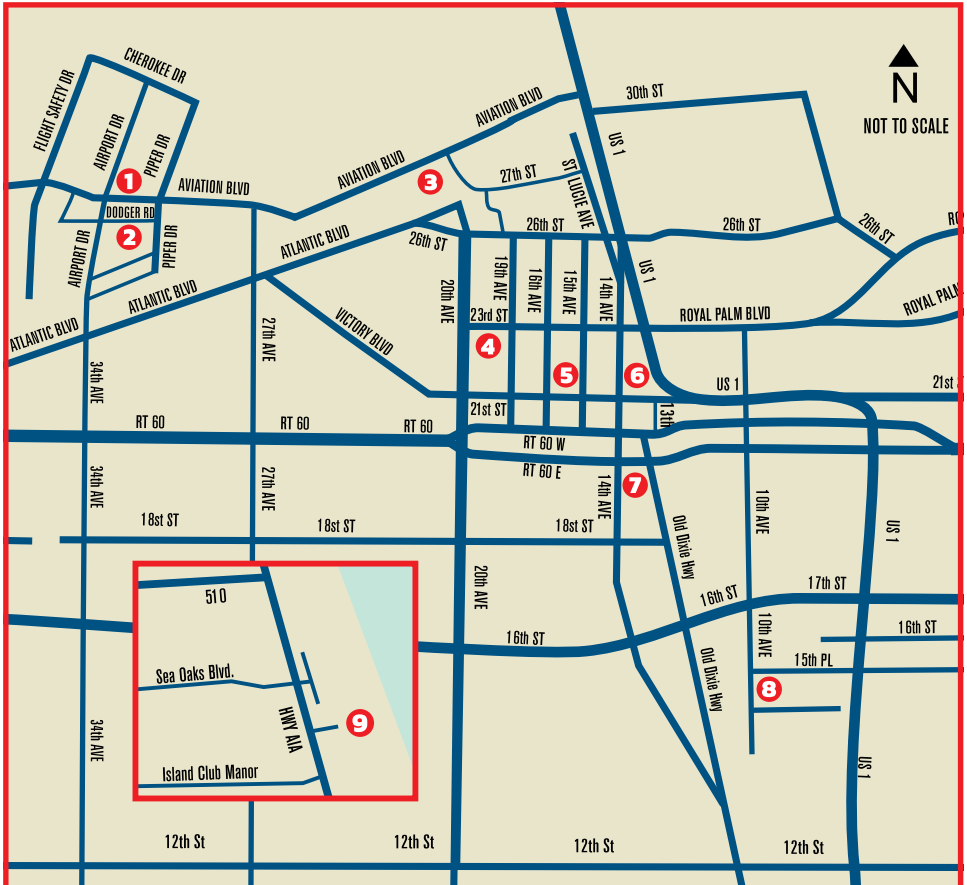

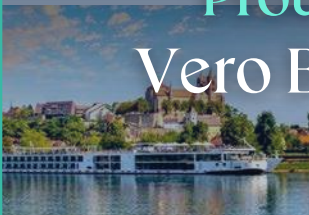

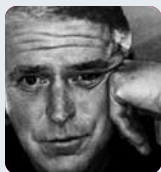

Now a days she more so sits back and runs the show along with her team of agents while she grooms her 3 yr old son for the world of entertainment. Co-Founder and Director of Film Fest Tucson.



JOSH DRAGOTTA has been directing and editing films over the past two decades. His films have been selected in festivals both nationally and internationally and his editorial work has garnered him Clio Awards in theatrical advertising. His editorial career started in short form documentaries including for such titles as *Murder On The Orient*, *The Magnificent Seven*, and *La La Land*. His theatrical and Television marking has included such titles as *Percey Jackson* and *The Olympians*, *Bullet Train*, and *Severance*. His Last Film *Satan's Angel: Queen of The Fire Tassels* was an official selection of Outfest.

As an editor his most recent work includes short films for The Carter Center celebrating the late president's 100th birthday, The Kennedy Center Honors honoring Barry Gibb, Renée Flemming, and The Grateful Dead as well as The Mark Twain Prize For Comedy honoring Kevin Hart and Conan O'Brien. As a filmmaker that is both an editor and a director Josh approaches his storytelling from a unique audio and visual experience, for him it is escapism. "I enjoy telling stories that entertain, that take you on a journey. The idea that I can transport someone to another place through pictures and sound is so exciting."



LISA BELCHER is an award-winning director, actor, writer, and producer working through her production company, Jump Rock Pictures. She directed the feature thriller *House of Abraham*, starring Natasha Henstridge and Lin Shaye, which received a theatrical run and is now available on streaming, with Blu-ray and DVD releases forthcoming.

Her short films have screened internationally, winning multiple awards including Best Director, and have secured distribution. Lisa is currently developing her next feature, the romantic comedy *Dirty Words*, scheduled to shoot in Austin, Texas this fall. She is passionate about telling character-driven stories that explore human connection and linger with audiences long after the screen goes dark.
